**Youth Development Worker (18 hours part time - £10, 408pa)**

**(Equivalent Pro Rata to £ 20,384 pa)**

We need a Youth Development Worker who can work with young people, and their local communities to identify local needs, and organise the provision of activities to meet those needs.

The job involves listening to young people, working with partners, assessing needs, and brokering service provision. The outcomes will be new clubs, projects, improved facilities, better practices and improved quality of life for young people and their communities.

If you want to make a difference to young people, you will need to have some experience of youth work (voluntary or employed), be educated up to degree level, and have a real ability to communicate across differing age ranges. This might suit an existing part-time youth worker wanting to expand his/her experience, or someone who is looking to develop a paid career in youth work.

You must be prepared to work across the county initially, have a full driving licence and car. Hours will be flexible, taking account of some evening work, and we have a "Family friendly" working policy.

Surrey Youth Focus is a voluntary sector charity that supports its 74 member organisations who work with over 75,000 young people a year, and is the voice of the voluntary youth sector. Our office is in Burpham, Guildford, where there is free car parking.
